THE GLOBAL WATER SUMMIT 2024: A CALL TO ACTION FOR WATER SECURITY IN A CHANGING WORLD

Actionable Outcomes

The Global Water Summit 2024 served as more than a platform for discussions. Key calls to action emerged:

- National Water Resilience Planning: Strong recommendations were made for governments worldwide to develop comprehensive, multisectoral water resilience plans that integrate climate adaptation, disaster risk reduction, and broader sustainable development goals.
- Global Marketplace for Water Technology: The Summit highlighted the need for a centralized knowledge-sharing platform and marketplace to accelerate the deployment of water solutions, facilitate technology transfer, and support capacity building.
- Corporate Water Stewardship: Businesses, particularly those operating in water-intensive industries, were urged to adopt and implement rigorous water stewardship standards, setting tangible goals for footprint reduction and sustainable water use.

A Moment for Transformation

The Global Water Summit 2024 made clear that a 'business-as-usual' approach is unacceptable when confronting the water crises of today and tomorrow. The commitments and ideas forged at the Summit have the potential to shape a global action plan, fostering a water-secure future that supports both human well-being and ecosystem health.

As the Global Water Summit 2024 drew to a close, a profound message resonated among participants: collaboration and immediate action are essential to secure a water-resilient future in a world facing unprecedented challenges. The Summit, themed "Security for a Changing Planet," underscored the complex interplay between water management, climate change adaptation, and sustainable development.

Major Themes and Outcomes

- Climate Change and Water Disruption: The
 water-climate nexus was a central focus.
 Delegates emphasized that immediate
 investment in climate adaptation strategies,
 alongside aggressive emissions reductions, is
 imperative to mitigate the most severe impacts
 of a changing hydrological cycle.
- The Power of Data: Data-driven decisionmaking was a recurring theme. Advanced analytics platforms, artificial intelligence applications, and sophisticated digital twin technologies highlighted the potential to optimize water infrastructure, anticipate and respond to emergencies, and promote sustainable water use across multiple sectors.
- Mobilizing Financial Resources: The Summit tackled the critical challenge of financing water innovation and infrastructure upgrades. Blended finance models, public-private partnerships, impact investing, and green bonds were identified as essential strategies for bridging the investment gap.
- Equitable Access: A Shared Responsibility:
 Discussions acknowledged that technological advancements must be deployed to serve communities globally. Speakers stressed that equitable access to water and sanitation is nonnegotiable and requires a concerted global effort.
- Integrated Solutions: The Summit fostered a collaborative mindset, recognizing the need for water utilities, policymakers, technology providers, the private sector, and NGOs to work together to develop holistic solutions for complex water challenges.

ELDOWAS LICENSE RENEWED

THE WATER SERVICES REGULATORY BOARD (WASREB) HAS RENEWED THE LICENSE OF THE ELDORET WATER AND SANITATION COMPANY (ELDOWAS) FOLLOWING A RESOUNDING VOTE OF CONFIDENCE FROM THE PUBLIC.

- Areas for improvement: Some concerns were raised around occasional water interruptions and billing queries.
