INTERRUPTION OF WATER SUPPLY FROM CHEBARA WATER TREATMENT PLANT.

This is to inform you that the water supply from the Chebara Treatment Plant will be temporarily interrupted. The interruption will begin on Wednesday, September 4th, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. and continue until Thursday, September 5th, 2024, at 9:00 p.m. It is to facilitate essential routine maintenance.

The areas which will be affected include:

- · All the customers along the Chebara-Eldoret Pipeline.

During this period, the water bowser services will also be unavailable, however, the other water treatment plants will remain operational to ensure the continuity of water supply to unaffected areas.


